The PDP is installed over new or existing outlets, allowing easy wire pulling and wire-up. Partition panels are connected to the PDP using a painted steel channel that is pop riveted to the Post, or by clips supplied by the panel manufacturer.

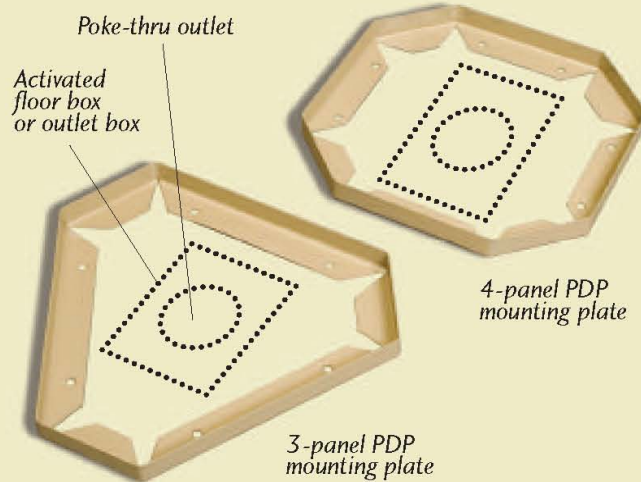

## Specifications:

3 panel or 4 panel post, custom height

20 gauge galvanized painted steel components

UL and C-UL Listed for 18 – 14 AWG,  
14 – 12 AWG or 9 – 10 AWG THHN conductors

20 AMP MAX circuit breaker

Holes punched for 2 power receptacles  
and 1 tele/data outlet

Standard holes provided in each face with  
temporary plastic covers shipped loose  
(receptacles not included)

A patent disclosure has been filed for this product.

The Power/Data Post® feeds wiring from poke-thru outlets, floor boxes, preset outlet boxes core drilled aftersets, and access floor openings.

## Ease of installation

- Select floor location to be serviced
- Activate new or existing floor outlet
- Mount and orient PDP mounting plate to desired position
- Pull power and data cables to the outlet
- Install and fix the PDP
- Wire-up all power and tele/data devices
- Install channel attachments and partition panels

## Benefits of the PDP

- Eliminates the cost of wire raceways in partitions, electrical distribution harnesses and related wire and cable equipment
- One PDP activates 1, 2, 3, or 4 workstations
- Eliminates unsightly flex conduit used with traditional floor based wire distribution systems
- Allows for cable changes in one workstation without service interruption to adjacent workstations served by that PDP
- Distributes power and tele/data from any type of floor outlet that fits beneath its mounting plate
- Permits wiring and cable changes during normal operation hours (except for poke-thru core drilling)
- Outlet access available either above or below desktop level
